

**Explanation:** This Resolution sets the fee schedule for clean up or abatement of hazardous substances.

**BEDMINSTER TOWNSHIP  
RESOLUTION No. 2014-099**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Bedminster has adopted Ordinance #2014-005 authorizing the Pottersville Volunteer Fire Company and the Far Hills – Bedminster Fire Department (the “Fire Companies”) to clean up or abate discharges of hazardous substances, suspected hazardous substances and further to authorize Township personnel to perform the same tasks, and thereafter to require reimbursement to the Fire Companies and to the Township of Bedminster for time and materials expended by the Fire Companies and the Township in connection with the clean up or abatement of any such discharges; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance #2014-005 further provides that a fee schedule shall be established by resolution of the Township Committee as amended from time to time; and

**WHEREAS**, costs shall include but shall not necessarily be limited to the following: Township costs, Fire Company costs, including actual labor costs of all personnel including workers’ compensation benefits, fringe benefits, administrative overhead; cost of equipment operation; cost of materials; and the cost of any outside contract for labor and materials.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Bedminster, Somerset County, that the following fee schedule be adopted:

Ladder Truck (Aerial or Platform)	\$200.00 per hour
Class “A” Pumper	\$150.00 per hour
Fire Tanker	\$150.00 per hour
Rescue/Haz-Mat/Other Pumper	\$100.00 per hour
Support Vehicles	\$ 50.00 per hour
Labor Rate Per Man	\$ 35.00 per hour

The Fire Companies and the Township of Bedminster will bill all responsible parties for all respective materials expended, equipment damaged, or supplies purchased to support operations at the incident at replacement cost plus a 10% administrative cost.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Fire Companies will be responsible for billing and collecting their reimbursements/costs and when Township departments (i.e. Fire Prevention, and/or Police) are involved, then these departments will bill/collect and forward to the Township Treasurer’s office.
