

EXPLANATION: A Resolution of Support (Concurrence) for the repeal of a mid-block crosswalk to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for Route 202 in Bedminster Township

**BEDMINISTER TOWNSHIP
RESOLUTION NO. 2015-106**

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) recently completed a traffic investigation on Route 202 in Bedminster Township; and

WHEREAS, the NJDOT investigation revealed that the mid-block crosswalk, located at milepost 32.4 on Route 202, is no longer supported and should be removed; and

WHEREAS, NJDOT requires a certified resolution of concurrence from the governing body of the Township of Bedminster in order to repeal this mid-block crosswalk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Bedminster, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that it supports the repeal of a mid-block crosswalk located at approximate milepost 32.4, beginning at a point 935 feet north of the northerly curb line of Elm Street and extending six (6) feet northerly therefrom on Route 202 in Bedminster Township, as recommended by NJDOT.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to NJDOT as requested.
