

## PET LICENSING INFO

Dog and Kennel licenses must be obtained by **January 31st of each year**. If a dog is licensed after January 31st, the late fee will be an additional \$10. If you have recently moved to the area or acquired a dog, late fees can be waived if proper documentation can be produced (adoption paperwork, etc.). Owners of unlicensed dogs will be subject to the penalty as provided by law.

A completed application form and current rabies inoculation certificate must be filed with the Bedminster Township Animal Registrar for each dog to be licensed. Dog Application should be mailed to the Municipal Building, One Miller Lane, Bedminster, NJ 07921. Questions can be directed to the Animal Registrar at 908-212-7000 x 427.

Neutered/Spayed Dog /Cat	1 year \$12.00
	3 year \$30.00*
Non-Neutered/Spayed Dog	1 year \$15.00
	3 year \$40.00*

*\* Three (3) year licenses will be available only with a valid 3 yr. rabies vaccination. This means the certificate needs to be good for the entire 3 years the animal is to be licensed for (Example - an owner cannot get a 3-year license in 2016 if the vaccination expires before November 2018).*



## DOG PARKS



**Burnt Mills Dog Park**  
**River Road Dog Park**

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Bedminster Township has two (2) dog parks for our four legged friends. Each park is approximately a half acre in size and feature secure double-gated entries, waste disposal bags and receptacles. Both parks are easily accessible from their parking lots, open dawn to dusk and for dogs of all sizes. Water is not available at either park. Users are to adhere to the posted rules and regulations.

**River Road Dog Park** is located inside the Township's River Road Park at the corners of Routes 202/206 South and River Road in Bedminster, and behind the historic Jacobus Vanderveer House & Museum. The dog park is accessible from the main park entrance on River Road and is a snow fenced 1/2 acre park with a double-gated entry.

**Burnt Mills Dog Park** is located inside Burnt Mills Park located on Burnt Mills Road approximately one mile from the corners of Route 202/206 South and Burnt Mills Road in the Pluckemin section of Bedminster Township. Burnt Mills Dog Park is a little over a quarter of an acre with a chain link fence and double-gated entry. The park has benches for visitors and is adjacent to a playground and picnic pavilion.

## DOG PARK RULES

All persons who utilize the township dog parks must obey the following Bedminster Township Dog Park Rules and Regulations:

1. *Dog Park open sunrise to sunset.*
2. *Use is at owner's risk. Bedminster Township is not responsible for any injuries you or your dog(s) may suffer.*
3. *No dog in heat may enter the dog park.*
4. *Puppies and dogs must be properly inoculated and display current license.*
5. *No more than three (3) dogs per person.*
6. *No food, bones, rawhide or chew toys in dog park as dogfights may result.*
7. *Close and secure gates before releasing dog into dog park.*
8. *The "Pooper-Scooper Law" will be strictly enforced inside as well as outside the dog park.*
9. *No dogs known to be aggressive towards other dogs or people (or exhibiting any threatening behavior) may enter dog park.*
10. *Dog owners are responsible for controlling their dogs at all times. Owners must closely supervise their dogs and at no time should an owner leave the run without their dog (s).*
11. *Parents are strongly discouraged from bringing children under 9 years of age into the dog park. Children should not be permitted to run with or chase dogs in the dog park.*
12. *Dogs must be on a leash outside the dog park.*
13. *Remove and dispose of personal items (e.g., chairs, water and dispensers, and bowls, etc.) from dog park after each use.*

## DIRECTIONS

### TO RIVER ROAD DOG PARK

#### **Traveling North on 202/206 (from The Hills)**

*Route 202/206 North. Stay in right lane on Route 202/206 North and take River Road jug handle that crosses 202/206 and enters onto River Road (jug handle located at first light and before AT&T Entrance). River Road Park entrance is immediately on the right. \*Follow park gravel roadway to parking lot adjacent to the ball fields.*

#### **Traveling South of 202/206 (from Bernardsville)**

*Follow 202 South through Bedminster and make left at traffic light (by Delicious Heights Restaurant) onto 202 South/Somerville Road. Merge onto 202/206 South and stay in the right lane. Take a right at the River Road jug handle. \*Follow directions above.*

### TO BURNT MILLS DOG PARK

#### **Traveling South on 202/206 (from The Hills)**

*Follow 202/206 South to Pluckemin. Make right onto Burnt Mills Road (by Colonial Liquors). Follow Burnt Mills Road for approximately 1 mile. Park entrance on the right.*

#### **Traveling North on 202/206 (from Bridgewater)**

*Follow 202/206 North to Pluckemin. Make left onto Burnt Mills Road (by Colonial Liquors). Follow Burnt Mills Road for approximately 1 mile. Park entrance on the right.*
