

Bulky Waste Rules & Regulations

Who can apply for a Bulky Waste Permit?

1. Any township resident
2. Any tenant of a rented property, provided the rental property is their primary residence
3. Commercial Property owners or tenants DO NOT qualify.

Acceptable Proof of Residency:

1. Drivers license
2. Property Tax Bill
3. Voter registration card

How can I apply?

Registration forms are available in Town Hall, Monday-Friday 8am-4pm. The registration is also available on the town's website www.bedminster.us under forms and registrations. The form can be mailed in to:

If payment is mailed in please make the check payable to Bedminster Township.

Acceptable Vehicles:

Passenger vehicles, pickup trucks and SUVs. Open trailers with no more than 1 axle will be accepted. NO box, dump or rack body trucks or enclosed trailers will be permitted.

Acceptable Bulky Waste Items:

Bulky Waste is defined as JUNK, non recyclable materials such as furniture, mattress, toys, carpeting, household appliances (refrigerators and freezers must have their doors removed) passenger vehicle tires (without rims), electronics and latex paint IF it is dried out, fencing

Unacceptable Bulky Waste:

Recyclable items: cardboard, newspaper, glass plastic, etc

Hazardous materials: oil based paints, florescent tubes, gasoline, kerosene, diesel fuel, pesticides. Chemicals, auto products (antifreeze, transmission fluid, brake fluid, used oil filters, car batteries. Propane tanks, appliances with refrigerant (unless tagged by authorized appliance technician as having been removed)

Contractor, industrial or business materials, household garbage

Acceptable Vegetative Waste:

Tree parts not to exceed 6ft in length and 6 inches in diameter.

Leaves (bags MUST be removed at time of disposal).

Unacceptable Vegetative Waste:

Grass clippings, stumps, roots, hay or firewood.
