

BEDMINSTER TOWNSHIP ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION

March 28, 2012 Special Meeting Minutes

APPROVED:

The Bedminster Township Environmental Commission held their regular meeting on Wednesday, March 28, 2012 commencing at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Municipal Building, Main Meeting Room, One Miller Lane, Bedminster, NJ. WILLOW SCHOOL APPLICATION:

Mark Biedron, Co-Founder of the Willow School and James Madsen of Apgar Associates, Site Engineer appeared to discuss the Environmental Scoping Document for the planned new building at the school. The school currently has 141 students in grades PreK-8th. They are rapidly growing and need more space. Now they are ready to proceed with the next planned building, which is a Health and Wellness Center. The new building will be a zero net waste campus. Mr. Biedron provided an overview of the new building, showing sketches of the exterior and a floor plan of the interior.

Motion to recommend that an EIS is not needed made by Brian Fahey and seconded by Jon Gibson.
