

EXPLANATION: This Ordinance authorizes appropriating \$330,500.00 for Various Capital Improvements in Bedminster Township.

**BEDMINSTER TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE #2013-011**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Bedminster, in the County of Somerset, New Jersey that the sum of \$330,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following purposes:

A.	Purchase of Various Heavy Equipment, Motor Vehicles and Equipment for the Public Works Department as part of the regular vehicle replacement program.
B.	Road Management Plan including, but not limited to, the reconstruction, repair and mitigation of roads, drainage and stormwater systems on various Township roads.
C.	Purchase of Various Police Equipment including, but not limited to, radio equipment, laptop computers and mobile data terminals (MDT)
D.	Purchase of a Police Department SUV, including but not limited to, the necessary equipment to outfit the vehicle for use by the Police Department.
E.	Street Lighting Maintenance and Replacement Plan including, but not limited to, the repair and replacement of street lighting along Township roads located within the Hills Development.
F.	Facility Improvements, including but not limited to the following structures: Police/Court Building, DPW Building, Municipal Building and various rental buildings

Any grant moneys received for the purposes described above hereof shall be applied to direct payment of the cost of the improvements and shall reduce the amount authorized from the capital improvement fund to the extent that such funds are so used.

The period of usefulness is five years or more. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
