

EXPLANATION: This Ordinance authorizes Bedminster Township's 80% share of the purchase of various equipment for the Far Hills-Bedminster Fire Department at a cost not to exceed \$48,000 and authorizes Bedminster Township's share of the purchase of various equipment for the Pottersville Volunteer Fire Company at a cost not to exceed \$32,000.

**BEDMINSTER TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE No.2015-006**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Bedminster, in the County of Somerset, New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I. The Township Committee hereby determines and states that it is in the best interest of the Township to authorize Bedminster Township's 80% share of the purchase of equipment for the Far Hills-Bedminster Fire Department.

SECTION II. The Township Committee hereby determines and states that it is in the best interest of the Township to authorize Bedminster Township's share of the purchase of equipment for the Pottersville Volunteer Fire Company.

SECTION III: The Sum of \$80,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following purposes:

A.	Purchase of various equipment to improve the Far Hills-Bedminster Fire Department's ability in providing assistance with rescue, firefighting and training operations.
B.	Purchase of various equipment to improve the Pottersville Volunteer Fire Company's ability in providing assistance with rescue, firefighting and training operations.

Such Sum being now available and having been provided for in the duly adopted budget of the Township of Bedminster in the current year.

SECTION IV: Any grant moneys received for the purposes described above hereof shall be applied to direct payment of the cost of the improvements and shall reduce the amount authorized from the capital improvement fund to the extent that such funds are so used.

The period of usefulness is five years or more. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
