

PET LICENSING INFO

Dog licenses must be obtained by **January 31st of each year**. After February 1st, the late fee is \$10 per dog. Owners of unlicensed dogs will be subject to the penalty as provided by law. If you have recently moved to the area or acquired a dog, late fees can be waived if proper documentation can be produced (adoption paperwork, etc.).

A completed application form and current rabies inoculation certificate must be filed with the Bedminster Township Animal Registrar for each dog to be licensed. Applications for licenses are available at Town Hall, One Miller Lane, Bedminster from 8 am to 4 pm, Monday — Friday. Applications are also available on the town website www.bedminster.us. Questions can be directed to the Animal Registrar at (908) 212-7000 x 427.

LICENSING FEES

Neutered/Spayed Dog	1 year \$12.00 3 year \$30.00*
Non-Neutered/Spayed Dog	1 year \$15.00 3 year \$40.00*

** Three (3) year licenses will be available only with a valid 3 yr. rabies vaccination. This means the certificate needs to be good for the entire 3 years the animal is to be licensed for (Example - an owner cannot get a 3-year license in 2018 if the vaccination expires before November 2020).*



GENERAL INFORMATION

Bedminster Township has two (2) leash-free dog parks for our four legged friends. Each park is approximately a half acre in size and feature secure double-gated entries, waste disposal bags and receptacles. Both parks are easily accessible from their parking lots, open dawn to dusk and for dogs of all sizes. Water is not available at either park.

Dog Park Rules have been established to ensure good manners and promote a safe environment. All park patrons must comply with the posted rules for the safety of every dog and visitor to the leash-free area and the parks at large. Dogs must be on a leash outside the leash free areas.

River Road Dog Park is located inside the Township's River Road Park at the corners of Routes 202/206 South and River Road in Bedminster. The leash-free park is a little over a half acre area with shade trees, a chain link fence, and double-gated entry.

Burnt Mills Dog Park is located inside Burnt Mills Park located on Burnt Mills Road approximately one mile from the corners of Route 202/206 South and Burnt Mills Road in the Pluckemin section of Bedminster Township. Burnt Mills Dog Park is a little over a quarter of an acre with a chain link fence and double-gated entry. The park has benches for visitors and is adjacent to a playground and picnic pavilion.

DOG PARK RULES

All users are hereby advised that the leash-free dog area within this park is an unsupervised recreational area within the Township of Bedminster, and are advised that the use of this facility is at their own risk. Users must abide by all rules and regulations governing the use of the Township of Bedminster parklands.

1. Dog Park open sunrise to sunset.
2. Use is at owner's risk. Bedminster Township is not responsible for any injuries you or your dog(s) may suffer.
3. No more than three (3) dogs per person.
4. Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and upon leaving the designated enclosed off-leash area. Township leash laws apply within the park.
5. Users must properly secure access gates upon entering and leaving the leash-free area.
6. Users must clean up after their dogs. The Township's "Pooper-Scooper" law applies inside the leash-free area as well as within the park.
7. Dogs must display current license and be properly inoculated.
8. No food, bones rawhide or chew toys in the dog park.
9. Remove all personal items (e.g. chairs, water and dispensers, toys and bowls) from leash-free dog area after each use!
10. Users are responsible, at all times, for the behavior and safety of their dog(s). Users must remain with their dog(s) at all times and at no time leave the leash-free area without their dog(s).
11. Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited in the leash-free area.
12. Dogs with a history of dangerous or aggressive behavior are prohibited.

DIRECTIONS

TO RIVER ROAD DOG PARK

Traveling North on 202/206 (from The Hills)

Route 202/206 North. Stay in right lane on Route 202/206 North and take River Road jug handle that crosses 202/206 and enters onto River Road (jug handle located at first light and before AT&T Entrance). River Road Park entrance is immediately on the right. *Follow park gravel roadway to parking lot adjacent to the dog park and ball fields.

Traveling South of 202/206 (from Bernardsville)

Follow 202 South through Bedminster and make left at traffic light (by Delicious Heights Restaurant) onto 202 South/Somerville Road. Merge onto 202/206 South and stay in the right lane. Take a right at the River Road jug handle. *Follow directions above.

TO BURNT MILLS DOG PARK

Traveling South on 202/206 (from The Hills)

Follow 202/206 South to Pluckemin. Make right onto Burnt Mills Road (by Colonial Liquors). Follow Burnt Mills Road for approximately 1 mile. Park entrance on the right.

Traveling North on 202/206 (from Bridgewater)

Follow 202/206 North to Pluckemin. Make left onto Burnt Mills Road (by Colonial Liquors). Follow Burnt Mills Road for approximately 1 mile. Park entrance on the right.
